Itinerary

Upon arrival at the Dublin Airport, you will be greeted by your driver/guide who will be with you throughout your stay in Ireland. We'll make our way to Northern Ireland with our first stop at **Longmeadow Cider** for a tour and tasting. Enjoy a fully immersive experience in the heart of Orchard County. Learn about the production process for their award-winning products as well as a visit to the Apple Pressing and Bottling Room. After we will make our way to our hotel for the evening at the **Armagh City Hotel** in Armagh. Dinner is included on property tonight.

Day 2: Monday, October 12th, 2026 | Armagh- Donegal | Mill Park Hotel |
Enjoy a full Irish Breakfast at our hotel this morning. Today we'll continue our journey to Donegal. Upon arrival we will visit the **Triona Tweed Visitor Center**. Experience the history, skill, and craft that has gone into handweaving Donegal tweed for generations of as well as the chance to purchase authentic Irish Tweed. Later we will make our way to our hotel for the next two nights at Mill Park Hotel in Donegal. Dinner and the rest of the evening will be on your own.

Day 3: Tuesday, October 13th, 2026 | Donegal | Mill Park Hotel
Enjoy a full Irish Breakfast at our hotel this morning. Today we will depart for **Gleanveagh Castle** located in Glenveagh National Park. A 19th century Scottish Baronial style mansion built between 1867 and 1873 by Captain John Georg Adair. It features a four story keep surrounded by one of Ireland's finest gardens and offers a luxurious interior. After we will visit **Irish Premium Oysters** for a one hour guided tour by Oyster farmer Jimmy who will share his years of experience and explain what is involved in getting the oyster from the shores to a plate in restaurants worldwide. Watch a demonstration on how shuck an oyster and best of all get to taste one fresh out of the water. Later we will return to our hotel. Dinner and the rest of the evening will be on your own.

Day 4: Wednesday, October 14th, 2026 | Donegal- Derry | Maldron Hotel Derry Enjoy a full Irish Breakfast at our hotel this morning. Today we head to **Greencastle** known as an active fishing harbor, fresh seafood at famous restaurants like Kealy's Seafood Bar and its location as a base for exploring the Wild Atlantic Way's landscapes on the Inishowen Peninsula, offering a more authentic Irish experience away from crowded tourist spots. After some free time and lunch on your own we will make our way to Derry. Upon arrival we will enjoy a **historic guided walking tour** of the walled city. Tonight, we will check into our hotel for the evening at the **Maldron Hotel Derry**. Dinner and the rest of the evening will be on your own.

Day 5: Thursday, October 15th, 2026 | Derry- Belfast | Tensquare Hotel
Enjoy a full Irish Breakfast this morning. Today we leave Derry and make our way to the incredible Giant's Causeway, a natural formation of approximately 40,000 interlocking basalt columns on the coast of Northern Ireland, created by ancient volcanic activity around 60 million years ago. A UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1986, the site is renowned for its dramatic coastal views and diverse flora and fauna, including unique wildflowers and seabirds. After we will head towards Belfast stopping first a Glenshane Country Farm for a Sheepdog Demonstration. Join Jamese McCloy and his beautiful border Collies for a demonstration of the centuries old skill of sheep herding, watch as he directs his highly trained dogs, Moss, Tess, and Jess to lead the flock into the traditional wooden pens. Learn how to direct the dogs using gestures, whistles, and verbal commands in a fun and highly engaging experience. Tonight we will arrive at our hotel for the next two nights in Belfast at the Tensquare Hotel. Dinner is included on property this evening.

Enjoy a full Irish Breakfast this morning. This morning our first stop will be **Titanic Belfast**, an immersive attraction that tells the story of the RMS Titanic located on the original site where the ship was built. Explore ten interactive galleries featuring a dark ride, recreations of cabins, and a 7.6m scale model, bringing the sights, sounds, and stories of the Titanic and Belfast's maritime history to life. This afternoon we will visit the **Crumlin Road Gaol**, a historic, formerly working Victorian-era prison in Belfast. Closed in 1996 and having been extensively renovated it's been repurposed to tell stories of incarceration, executions, and political history through interactive displays and exhibits. Later we will return to our hotel and dinner and the rest of the night will be on your own.

Enjoy a full Irish Breakfast this morning. Today we will head back to Dublin for the final night of our tour. Upon arrival you will have a free day to experience Dublin at your own pace. Later we will head to our hotel for tonight at the **Trinity** City Hotel. Dinner and the rest of the evening will be on your own.
